Joining us: Judson True, Manager, Bureau of Surveying and Mapping.

Mr. True spoke to us about his new position within Public Works. Mr. True comes to the job with over 20 years of experience in government He expressed his intention to be a partner with the City/County Surveyor. His role will be assisting the C/C Surveyor to ensure a timely review process. He also wants to hear from the private professional community: what is working, what isn't, and proposed possible meetings with the community to develop better procedures throughout the project cycles. Mr. True also indicated that CCSF is working to keep project review and getting maps to recordation is a priority. He also indicated that the selection process for a City/County Surveyor is on-going and he expects a possible selection by Spring. New Public Works permit tracking softward (which will also include mapping applications) is in the works, and SF-CLSA can expect an early version for review and comment.

Also, the Bureau of Street-use and Mapping is no longer, see the new PW org chart here (now BSM is the Bureau of Surveying and Mapping). Note: the City and Co. Surveyor is now on the PW Org chart! A significant improvement for that position. <u>Organization | Public Works</u>
